

This satirical horror film was written by Frank DeSautter, the same man who helped write Joker He also wrote it with help from Christopher Titus, Jordan Schlansky, and Tom Papa. The original story has a very different feel than the remake. This version is interesting because it portrays life in an alternate universe that reflects many aspects of our own lives.
